

RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN APPRENTICE ADVANCEMENTS

In order to advance in pay, apprentices must meet the following requirements:

- 3+ Have current First Aid and CPR certification"
 - c+ Initial CPR/First-Aid certification must be completed with a "live" instructor.
 - d+ The JATC offers monthly CPR/First Aid/AED courses for a \$50.00 cash/check" refundable deposit.

- 4+ Submit required on-the-job (OJT) training hours into the Apprentice Portal. Journeyman/Foreman approval is mandatory.
 - c+ Apprentices are responsible for requesting raises by e-mailing cfxcpego.gpvsgwuuB.gvcux@ti

- 5+ 1,600 hours of OJT hours and a completed Tool List signed by the apprentice's Journeyman" or Foreman are required for the first wage increase. 800 hours of OJT hours are required for" all remaining pay increases.

- 6+ Completion of each semester of school with a passing grade of 85% or higher.
